

- Allah (ﷺ) told us to follow the right path (دین).
- And to guide us He sent His book (Quran) and the Prophet Muhammad (産場).

The Qur'an tells us....."what to do"
The Prophet ( tells us...."How to do"

Together both of them make البينه, the clear proof for the right path.

Example: The Qur'an tells us to offer Salat and the Prophet Muhammad ( ) told us how to offer Salat. Now that we have been told and shown the way to offer Salat we have the clear proof about it and we can not make any false excuse for not offering it.

- This Qur'an and the Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) have become a clear proof for everyone, even the disbelievers, the Christians and the Jews for following the path of Allah (ﷺ).
- And anyone who would follow this clear proof would become "The Best Of All Creations" and who would deny would become "The Worst Of All Creations".

## CLEAR PROOF

## Column-A (Al-QUR'AN)

- 1. Take due care of all the prayers and the middle prayer and stand before Allah in total devotion. (AI-Bagarah-238)
- 2. O you who believe, fasting is decreed upon you as it was decreed upon those before you, so that you may be God-fearing. (Al-Bagarah-183)
- 3. And be steadfast in prayer, and give Zakat. Whatever good you send forth for yourselves, you will find it with Allah. Certainly, Allah is watchful of what you do. (AI-Bagarah-110)
- 4. And proclaim to people about (the obligation of) Hajj, so that they should come to you on foot, and on every camel turned lean, traveling through every distant hilly pathway. (Al-Ĥaj-27)

## Column-B (HADEES)

- 1. Allah's Prophet (ﷺ) started saying, "Labbaik" from Dhul-Hulaifa when his mount stood upright carrying him.
  (Bukhari-Vol. 2, Book 26, Number 591)
- 2. Allah's Prophet ( ) said, "No zakat is imposed on less than five away of date; no zakat is imposed on less than five away of silver, and no zakat is imposed on less then five camels."

  (Bukhari-Vol. 2, Book 24, Number 538)
- 3. The Prophet ( said, "The imam is to be followed. Say the takbir when he says it; bow if he bows; if he says "Sami'a-l-lahu Liman hamida" say, "Rabbana-lakal hamd". Prostrate if he prostrates and pray sitting altogether if he prays sitting."

(Bukhari-Vol. 1, Book 11, Number 689)

4. The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Whoever does not give up forged speech and evil actions, Allah (ﷺ) is not in need of his leaving his food and drink (i.e. Allah (ﷺ) will not accept his fasting.)
