

Theme:

The surah of Test

- Allah (%) tells us to look at the morning and the night and to understand that just like the morning and the night, we face good or bad times in our life but these are our tests.
- If we have more to enjoy that does not mean that Allah (ﷺ) is happy. Instead this is our test to check whether we are **thankful** to Allah (ﷺ) or not.
- If we have less to enjoy that does not mean that Allah (※)
 is angry. Instead, this is our test to check our patience.
- Allah (ﷺ) will be happy with us if we share with others when we have more; and be patient and ask Him for help when we have less.
- Allah (ﷺ) gives us the example of the people of Aad, Samood and the Firoun who had a lot to enjoy but they became thankless and cruel; so Allah (ﷺ) punished them for their sins.
- Allah (ﷺ) tells us that those who remember Allah (攤) in all times (good or bad), will be called by Him happily to live in the bliss forever.


