Theme:

The surah of respect of the Ka'aba

Abraha and his army of Elephants !

Abraha was a king of Yemen. He was jealous of the Ka'aba as people from all Arab used to visit Ka'aba and Abraha wanted them to come to Yemen to the temple built by him. So he decided to attack and destroy Ka'aba. He gathered a huge army and the special thing about that army were the war elephants. No one had seen elephants in war in Makka before that. Abraha was very proud of his army and confident that he would win and destroy the Ka'aba. However Allah (ﷻ) had His own powerful plan. So when Abraha reached near Makka Allah (ﷻ) sent special birds called Ababeels who would throw small pebbles on that army. Those pebbles had the effect like powerful bullets and they destroyed all the army and the elephants. Abraha was killed too! So that's how Allah (ﷻ) saved Ka'aba.
