# ZAKAT

## The Compulsory Payment



- ❑ Zakat is the third pillar of Islam. It means compulsory payment of the due that is to give a fixed proportion of savings each year for upliftment of the poor. In this way it purifies our wealth by purifying our heart from greed. Zakat must be paid on all the different types of possessions like gold, silver, money, cattle, crops and business goods after one year's possession. It requires a yearly contribution of 2.5 percent of an individual's wealth and possessions. Apart from Zakat, the voluntary contribution is called Sadqa.
- ❑ With Zakat and Sadqa, Islam binds rich and poor in the bond of care and love.
