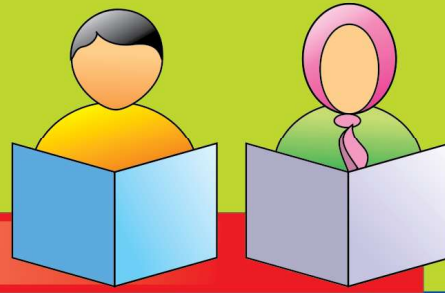
The Night

Theme:

The surah of Opposite Qualities

- Allah (ﷻ) tells us to look around and see the opposites around us like day and night, male and female and the different aims in the jobs that we do.
- Just like these, the qualities in our actions lead to opposite results.
- If anyone has the **three good qualities** of sharing with others, being conscious of Allah (ﷻ) in all actions and accepting the good (Dawaa), Allah (ﷻ) would lead him to the easy way to bliss (Jannat).
- On the other hand, if anyone has the **three bad qualities** of being a miser, thinking of himself as self-sufficient and denying the good (Dawaa), Allah (ﷻ) would leave him on the difficult way to hell fire and his wealth will not save him.

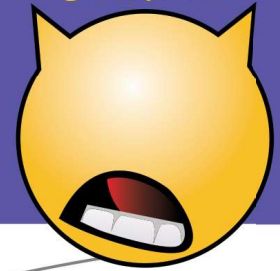

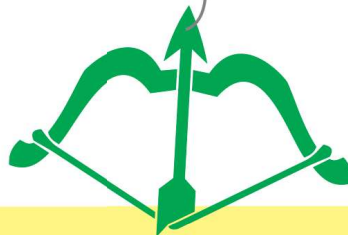

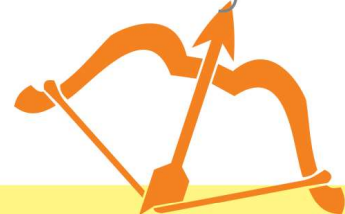
